3. College-wide Assessment Activity (led by Teresa and Laura)

Teresa stated that we are assessing ourselves for year two, we will continue the work from last year. The team, which includes Anne Cash, Tehia Glass, Laura Hart and Erica Moody is looking at college data. Today's work is for all programs.

The objectives for today are:

- Review last year's results and actions
- Reassess the status of each program on the rubric
- Determine an area for a program to improve upon
- Look at next year's goals

Laura instructed faculty to log into the link <https://edassessment.uncc.edu>. First, you will open the rubric then do part one and part two. Faculty will form into groups by program. The program director will facilitate. Record your ratings on the google form. You have 3 minutes per rubric. Next steps – compare today's results to last years. Responses on google form part two.

The faculty formed into groups by program and completed the activity.

The following faculty shared their thoughts from their group:

- Rob Pennington stated the lack of external feedback from former teachers/principals. What do we want from external stakeholders and from CMS? We can share our data with them. There is also the barrier of time.
- Rebecca Shore also stated that getting stakeholders together was a challenge as well as funds and time.
- Lynn Ahlgrim-Delzell said that turnover is a problem along with time. Setting up a WebEx meeting may be helpful.
- Laura Hart added that we have a P12 Advisory Board that may help. They meet four times a year. The group is available for feedback. This would not serve the doctoral programs though.
- Hilary Dack stated the low ratings on observations. They use video for candidates on observations and coaching.
- Jean Vintinner added that time and scheduling is a problem. Time is huge.

Teresa thanked everyone for doing these activities. We can improve in some areas. Our team will look over the data that you put in and bring back some actions for you. She showed a chart of data from last year compared to this year. We have lowered the bar, which is amazing. We still have some work to do. The data will be shared with you. We will look at your comments and report back out in January. Please start working on processes. In February, we will have data review meetings by program.
