Title: Research Grants

Purpose of Program: To support high-quality research that is relevant to policies and practices that affect the lives of young people ages 5 to 25 in the United States. Funded research projects should increase the understanding of programs, policies, and practices that reduce inequality in youth outcomes, and research that identifies, builds, and tests strategies to improve the use of research evidence in ways that benefit youth.

Funding Range: **\$100,000 to \$600,000 (Projects that reduce inequality)**
\$100,000 to \$1,000,000 (Projects that improve the use of research evidence)

Submission Deadline(s): **January 11, 2017 @ 4:00 pm (EST) – Letter of Inquiry**

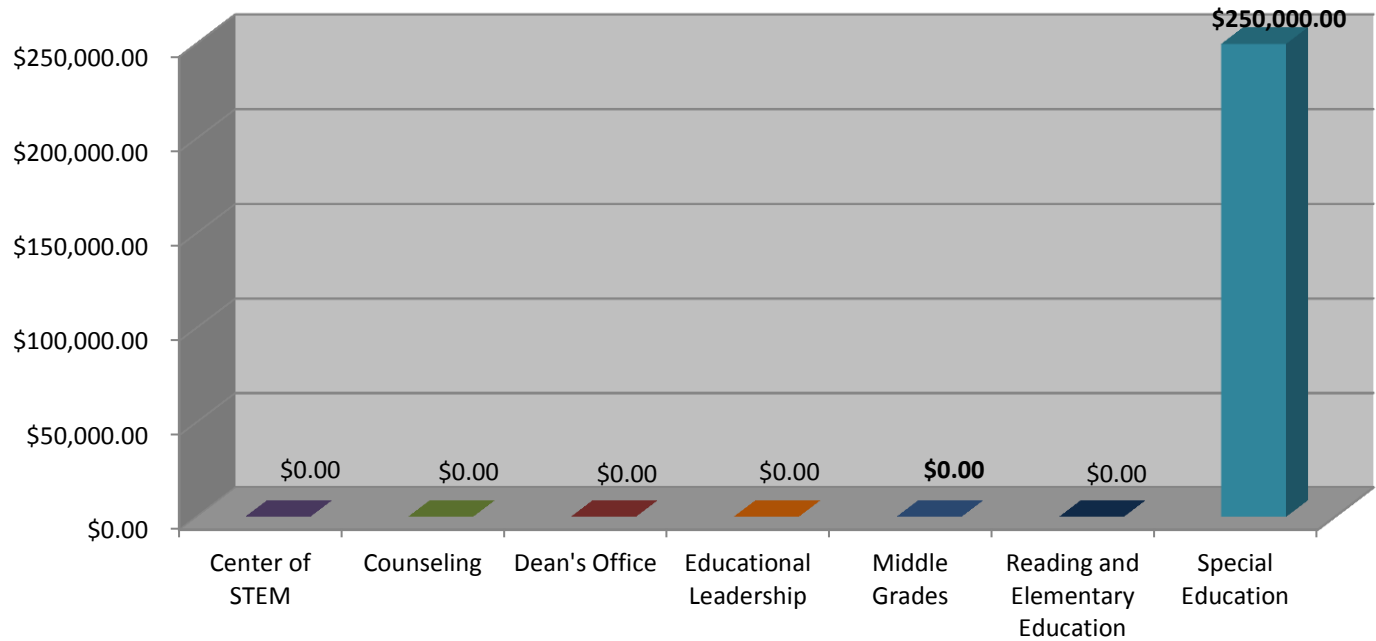
